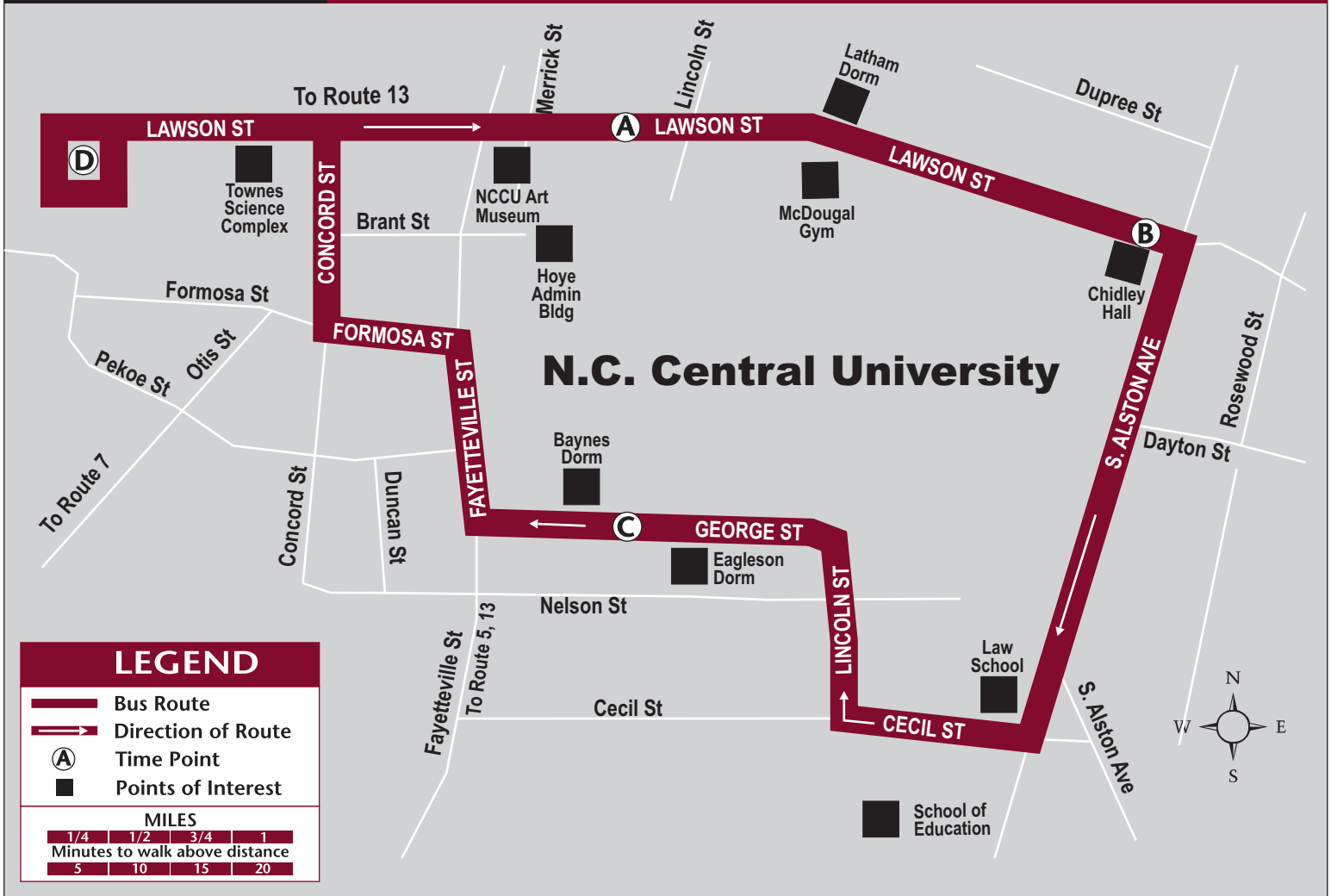

FARE FREE CAMPUS SHUTTLE

SERVICE HOURS

Fall & Spring: Operates from 7:30 a.m. to 10:30 p.m. while classes are in session.

TRANSFER POINTS

Route 5 to Hwy 15-501 can be boarded along Fayetteville Street.
 Route 7 to Southpoint Mall can be boarded along Concord Street.
 Route 12 to RTP can be boarded along Highway 55.
 Route 13 to Durham Technical Community College can be boarded along Lawson Street, Hwy 55, Fayetteville Street or Burlington Avenue.

ROUTE 14 DOES NOT TRAVEL TO THE DOWNTOWN TRANSFER FACILITY

Route 5, 7, and 12 travel to the Downtown Transfer Facility to transfer to additional routes. The regular fare policy applies when using any other DATA Routes.

RIDING THE BUS

The bus will stop at designated bus stops along this route. When the bus approaches, check the route number and destination sign above the windshield to make sure you have the right bus. Passengers may only get on or off at designated stops and shelters. As you board, please have exact change or your fare card ready. To notify the driver that you want to get off, pull the cord above the passenger window. The bus will stop at the next DATA stop or shelter along the route. If you have questions about reaching your destination, a customer service representative will be glad to provide assistance. WHEELCHAIRS

All DATA buses are wheelchair accessible and can hold up to two wheelchairs at one time. For more information about accessibility on DATA buses call, (919) 485-RIDE. For TTY service, call North Carolina Relay at 1-800-735-2962 and request to be connected to DATA.

Persons with a disability that prevent them from using regular bus service may qualify for the ACCESS. This is a special van curb-to-curb service that is available only to qualified disabled applicants. The ACCESS application process requires medical certification of the existing conditions. ACCESS vans operate during the same hours as DATA buses. For more about ACCESS, call (919) 560-1551.

HOW TO PAY

The fare boxes accept fare cards, coins and bills. Electronic fare boxes and bus operators do not make change. If change is owed after payment of bus fare, the fare box will issue a change card not cash. Change cards are redeemable on buses for fare only not cash.

Passes may be used anytime and are good for unlimited rides. The pass will be validated when used for the first time. The pass is valid for the remainder of the period indicated on the back of the pass. Passes are non-refundable and have no cash value. One-day passes are available on the bus. 5-day, 7-day and 30-day passes may be purchased at the Downtown Transfer Facility

and at the DATA Operations Center.

For the safety and comfort of all, DATA prohibits concealed weapons or hazardous materials; graffiti or other destruction of property; loud and unruly behavior; profanity or abusive language; loud music; smoking, transporting illegal drugs, eating and drinking.

BICYCLES

Bicycles are permitted on all DATA buses. A special rack on the front of the bus enables two bikes to be secured safely in an upright position. Cyclists can load bikes easily and quickly. There is no special license or additional fare for traveling with a bicycle.

HOLIDAY SERVICE

Holiday service is available on most routes. There is no service on Christmas Day. There is limited holiday service on the following holidays:

ID CARDS

With proper documentation, persons with disabilities and students up to age 18 are eligible for reduced fares. Customers are required to present a DATA ID Card when using reduced fares including cash fare or passes. Seniors (65 and over) and youth (12 and under) are eligible for free fare. Youth over 60 inches must obtain a DATA ID card to receive a free fare. DATA ID Cards may be obtained by appointment only at the DATA Operations Facility at 1907 Fay Street any weekday between the hours of 8:30 a.m. and 4:30 p.m.

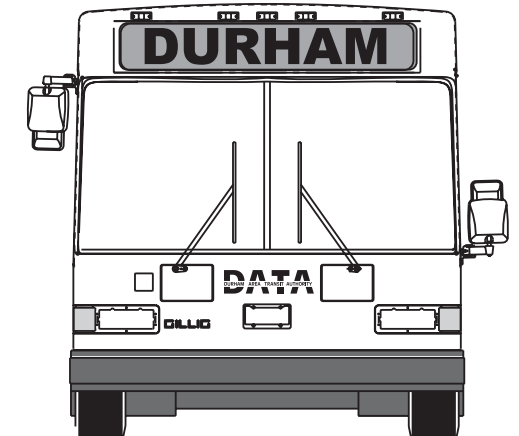
